

The project Our history is the European future was funded with the support of the European Union under the Programme "Europe for Citizens"

Applicable to the Strand 2 – Measure 2.1 "Town-Twinning"

Participation: The project involved **239** citizens, notably **78** participants from the SÜKÖSD NAGYKÖZSÉGI ÖNKORMÁNYZAT (**Hungary**), **44** participants from UDRUZENJE ZA RAZVOJ REGIJE VOJVODICUM KLASTER (**Serbia**), **34** participants from COMUNA ACATARI (**Romania**), **41** participants from Panonija EGTS (**Croatia**), **33** participants from OBEC MODRANY (**Slovakia**), and **9** participants from KLACR (**Czech Republic**).

Location/ Dates: The event took place in Sükösd, Hungary, from 30/07/2021 to 01/08/2021

Short description:

The day of 30/07/2021 was dedicated to Kick off meeting.

The day of 31/07/2021 was dedicated to Conference, Workshop, Dexterity and intellectual contests, Traditional cultural show.

The day of 01/08/2021 was dedicated to Project closing event.

6 events have been carried out within this project:

Event 1

Location / Dates: The event took place in Sükösd, Hungary, from 30/07/2021 to 30/07/2021 **Short description:** The kick-off / introductory meeting was the first opportunity for new members of delegations to meet again; new members could introduce themselves and discuss the events of the coming days. The tasks were distributed and other technical information was provided by the organizers.

Event 2

Location / Dates: The event took place in Sükösd, Hungary, from 31/07/2021 to 31/07/2021 **Short description:** The main event of the project, during the conference, presented all the good practices of the political and civilian representatives of each delegation based on historical traditions, which were intended to help strengthen European integration. The members of each delegation spoke, approaching the subject from their own point of view.

Event 3

Location / Dates: The event took place in Sükösd, Hungary, from 31/07/2021 to 31/07/2021 **Short description:** Based on the historical events heard on the conference, and using their attitudes, the representatives of the partner settlements worked in groups to develop five areas of intervention to reduce Euroscepticism. By presenting the five areas of intervention, they discussed what can be used to achieve the goal, and the workshop finally reached a consensus decision, which was used on the third day to develop the final strategy.

Event 4

Location / Dates: The event took place in Sükösd, Hungary, from 31/07/2021 to 31/07/2021 **Short description:** Mixed teams of delegations fought against each other in support of the local population and other members of the delegation. The intellectual quiz was about the history, achievements, and politics of the Union, while the dexterity games, though, are meant to support the forging of team spirit. The main purpose of the contest was to continue building relationships between delegation members in a more relaxed atmosphere after the all day long hard work, and to display everyone's knowledge and skills, using competition as a force for cohesion.

Event 5

Location / Dates: The event took place in Sükösd, Hungary, from 31/07/2021 to 31/07/2021 **Short description:** The programs prepared for the meeting by traditional teams of domestic and foreign delegations were introduced, which showcased the most typical traditions of a given settlement or country. The purpose of the presentation was for the participants of the meeting to get to know each other's traditions, dances, music, literary heritage, thereby increasing cohesion between nation and cultures.

Event 6

Location / Dates: The event took place in Sükösd, Hungary, from 01/08/2021 to 01/08/2021 **Short description:** From the individual areas of intervention that emerged from a conflict of opinion to a coherent strategy, it's goal is to enable individual communities to intervene at the level of citizens in popularizing EU policies and reducing Euroscepticism. The strategic interventions developed had a stimulating effect, presenting a positive vision for participants, embedded in the context of historical traditions, which when was put together in a European dimension, together with a good practice plan, could significantly increase the willingness to participate in solving future problems across the Union.
